

The **Costa del Sol** is known everywhere for its monuments, typical cuisine, traditions, beaches, and an amount of features that make it irresistible for any kind of tourists. All these virtues are strengthened by **the best weather in Europe**.



The area has a **Mediterranean climate**, with mild temperatures for the whole year. So much so that you can visit any part of the province wearing a T-shirt in the middle of November!

The Costa del Sol benefits from **365 sunny days** a **year**, and the short rains that pour usually do in the months of November and May.

The province of Málaga enjoys the warmest winter in Europe. The average daytime temperature in the period between from December to February is 18°C. then is when the mountains near Málaga block the cold Northerly winds. As an average, summer season lasts around eight months, from April to November, although temperatures often reach 20°C. in the other four ones left.
